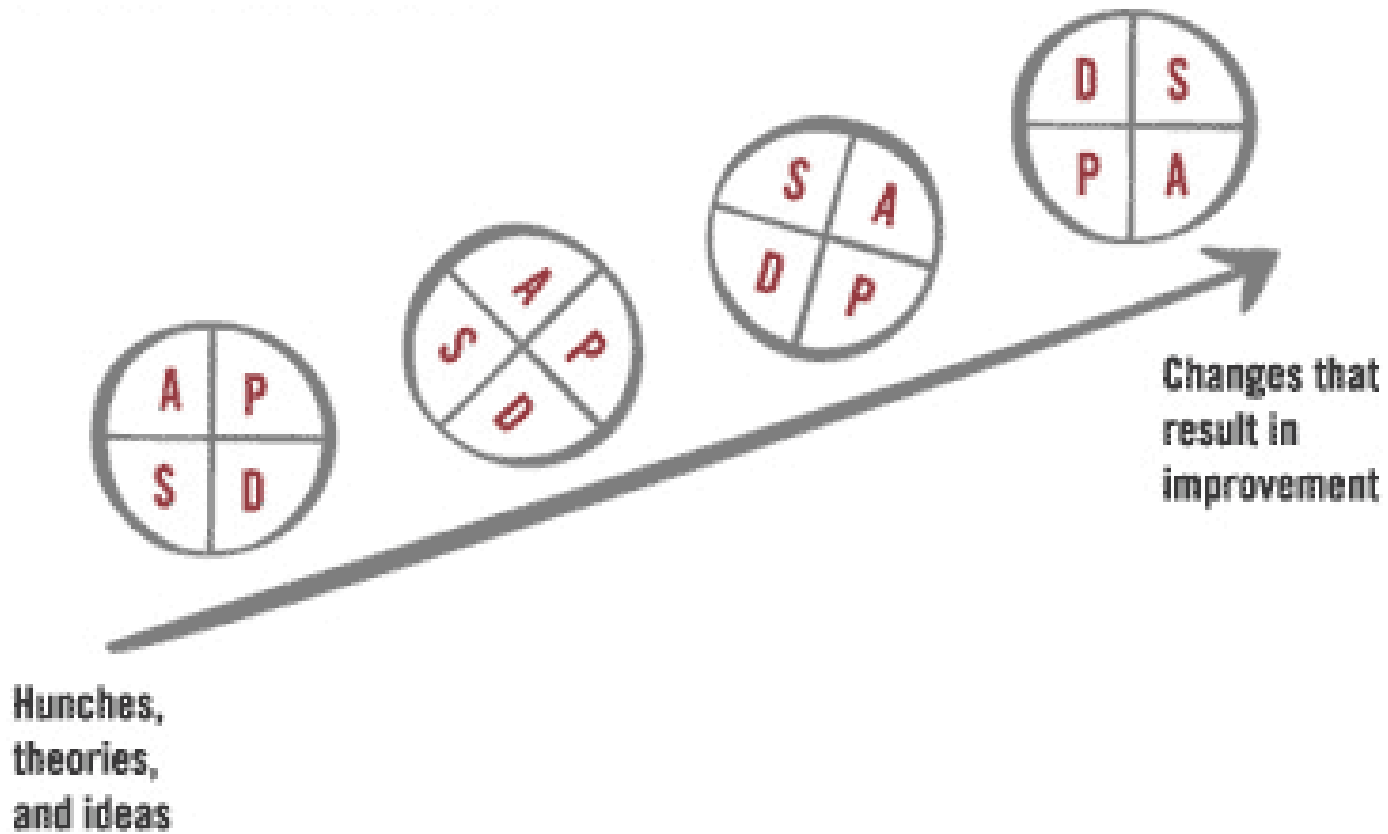

Aspirin (Ethics Enteric Coated Aspirin) 100mg Enteric coated Tablets Take ONE tablet ONCE daily	Aspirin (Ethics Enteric Coated Aspirin) 100mg Enteric coated Tablets Take ONE tablet ONCE daily	Continued	-
Atorvastatin (Zarator) 40mg Tablets Take ONE tablet ONCE daily	Atorvastatin (Zarator) 40mg Tablets Take ONE tablet ONCE daily	Continued	-
