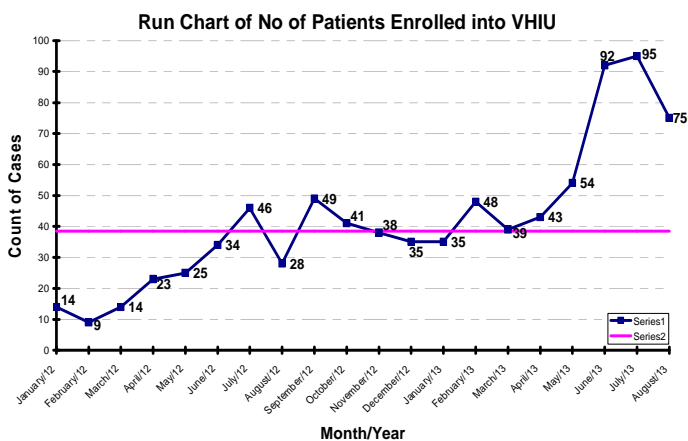
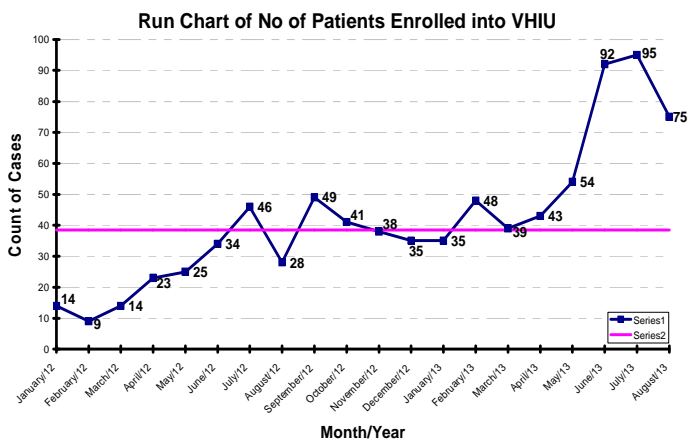
Progress

This will be a resource for other health professionals and services who wish to implement the changes.</p> <p>Transitions of Care: Goal Discharge Date (GDD) is assigned to every patient admitted to wards 33, 6 & 2 and the date is reviewed daily. POAC is showing a positive change with increased referrals and St John continues to avoid EC presentations for low acuity patients.</p> <p>Healthy Hearts- Community Rehabilitation: Programme started on schedule on 23 September with 2 patients with a further two patients started week</p>																								

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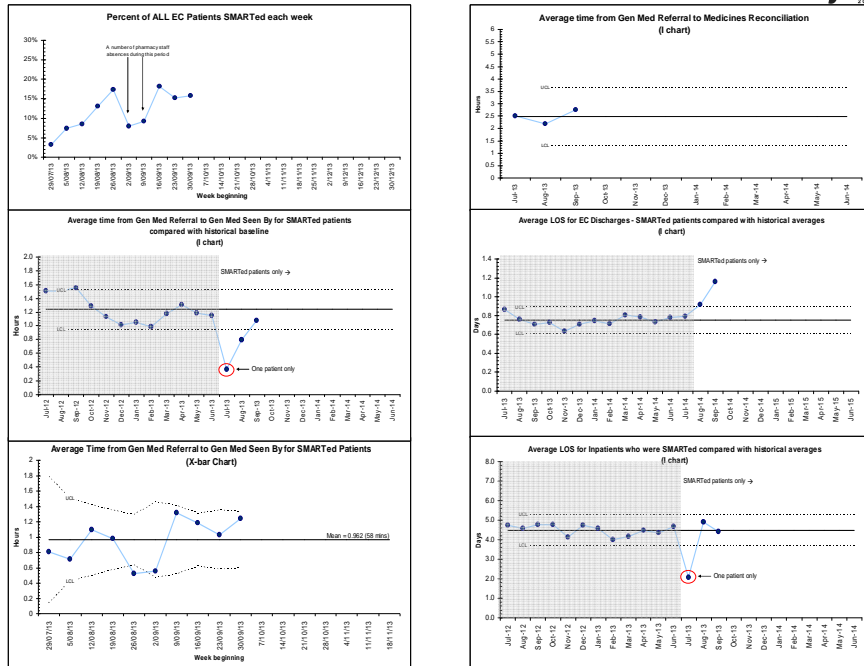
commencing 30th September 2013. The Team have 'prototyped' gym model of care and is held at the AUT gym.

VHIU: Has achieved its aim of enrolling the target number of patients and proving VHIU support reduces hospitalisation.



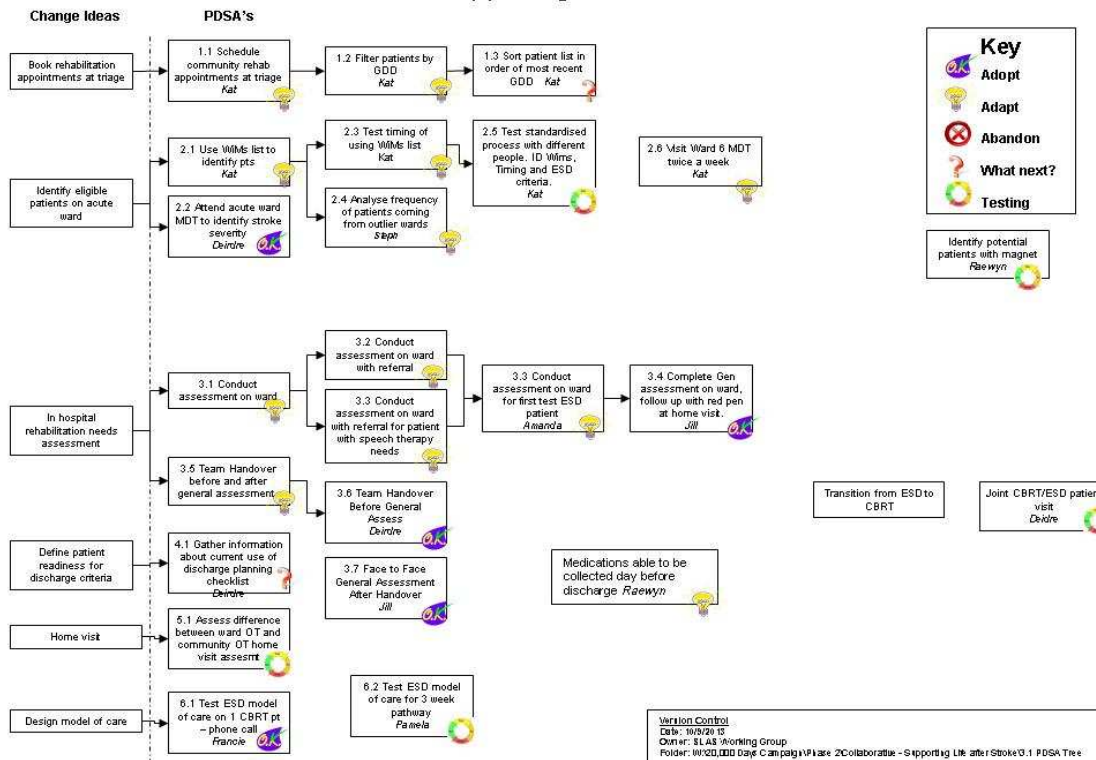
