Aim:

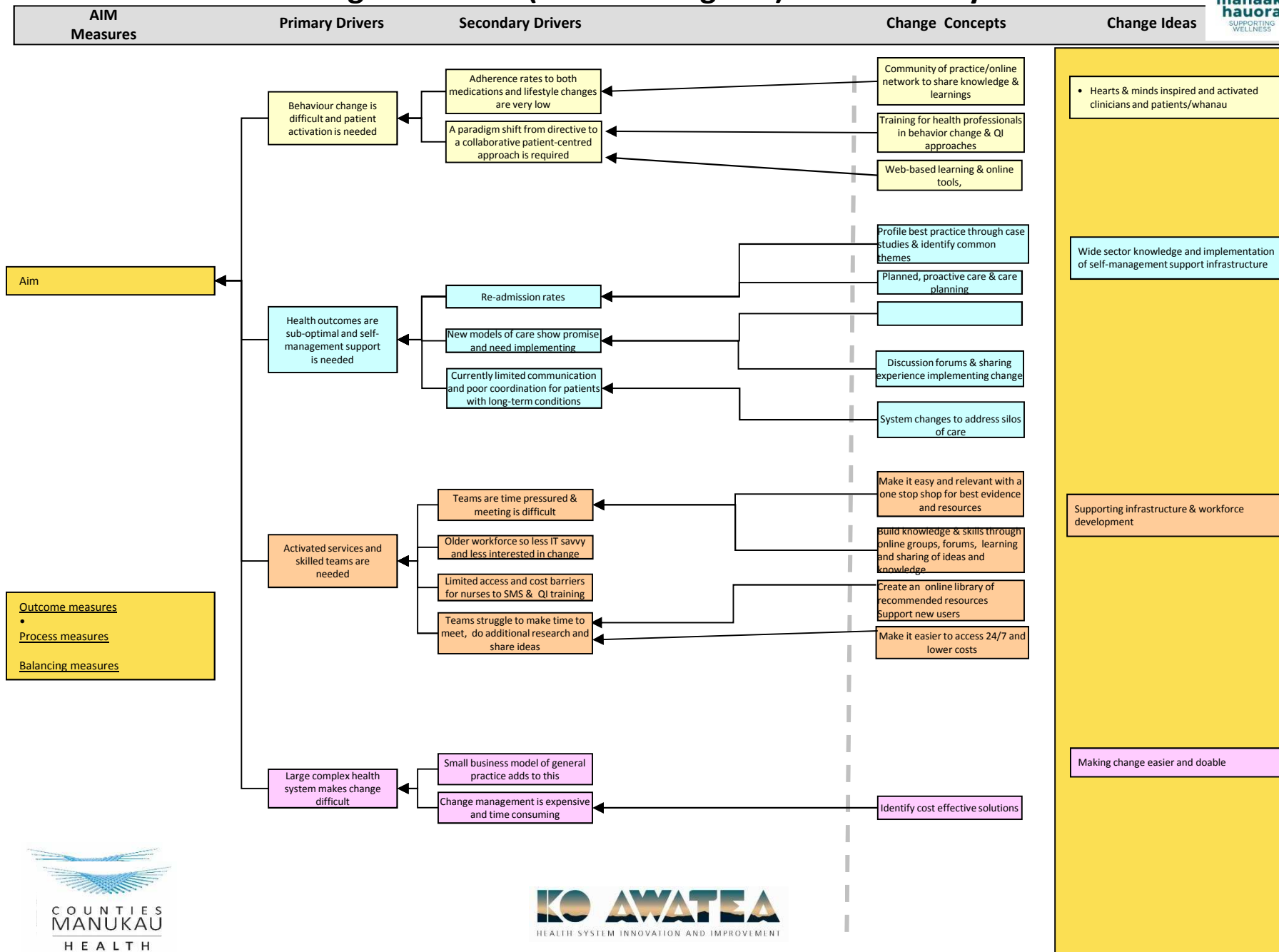

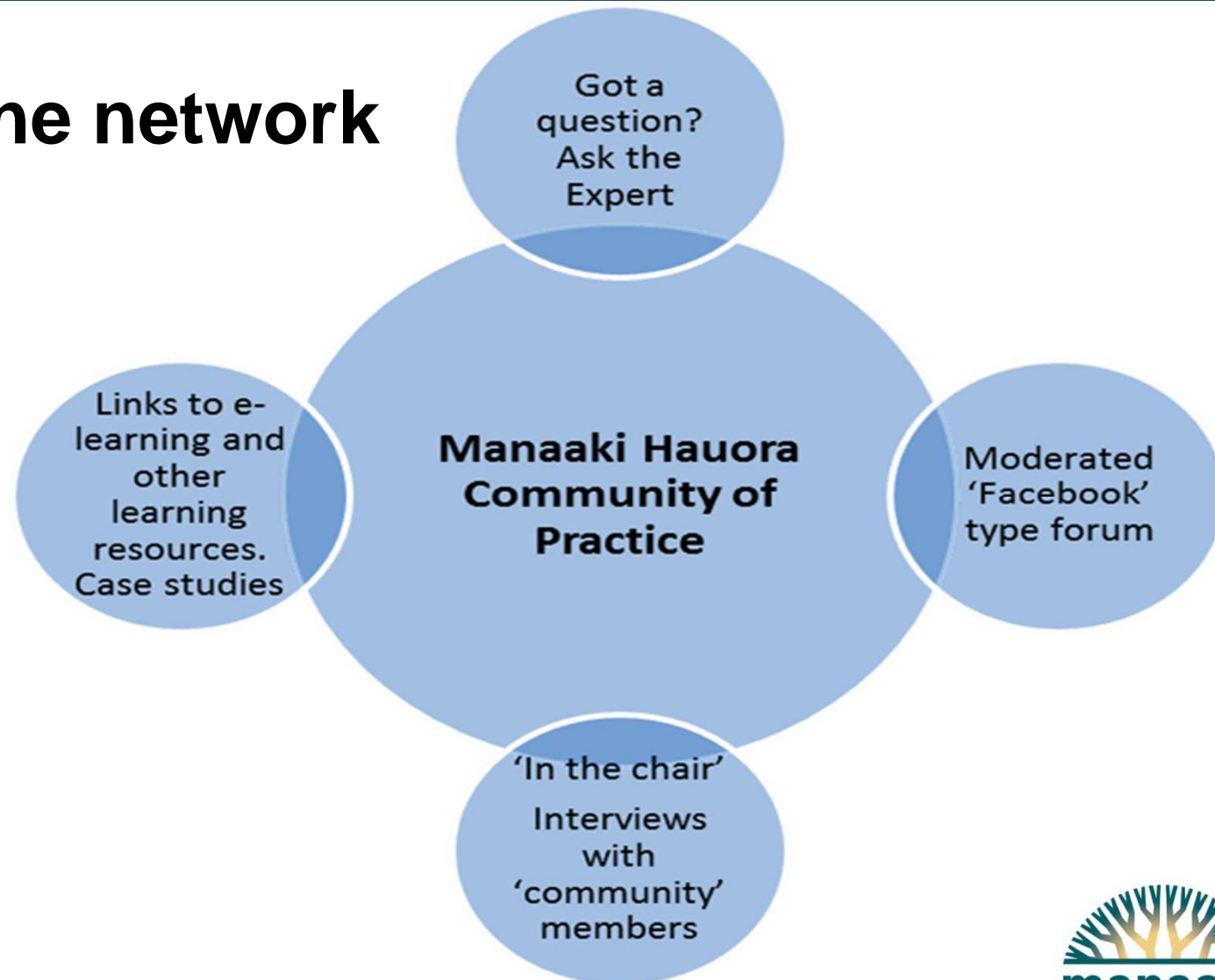
